### Overseas Travel 2016

The SACE is delivered in a number of schools in Malaysia and China, where it is known as the SACE International. Students undertaking the SACE International gain the SACE qualification, which is recognised by universities around the world.

Partnership agreements are in place between the SACE Board and the schools delivering the SACE International. These agreements set out the respective undertakings of each party, and include requirements for the SACE Board to provide teaching and learning support to the schools. As such, each year the SACE Board sends staff to the schools in Malaysia and China that deliver the SACE International, to provide professional development, training, and other forms of support to the schools. These schools pay a licence fee to the SACE Board to deliver the SACE; this fee represents an important source of revenue for South Australia.

In addition, the SACE Board continued to expand delivery of the SACE International within South-East Asia, in particular in China. Colleges in Vietnam have also expressed interest in delivering the SACE International.
